Solemn Holyday of Archangel Michael and all the Angels

The Heavenly Powers, or angels, are spirits sent to serve "those who shall inherit salvation". They are guardians and guide both to individual human beings and to societies. The lower ranks are believed to be in charge of the material world, of its development and evolution. The choirs of angels are constantly participating in the heavenly liturgy, surrounding God's altar and singing the Thrice Holy Hymn.

The angels in heaven are countless and are divided traditionally, if somewhat arbitrarily, into nine orders called "choirs," constituting three hierarchies. The first hierarchy comprises the Seraphim, the Cherubim and the Thrones; the second, the Dominations, the Virtues and the Powers, the third, the Principalities, the Archangels and the Angels.
